Reina Merlo, 81 years old, has worked as a traditional midwife for more than 50 years in Northern Olancho and had been suffering a large mass on the back of her neck for nearly 25 years. Recently she travelled for 6 hours to the Good Samaritan Medical Center for an abdominal ultrasound not having hope to solve her long-term suffering. Our physician provided the requested services but also proposed her as a candidate for the next Jackson Healthcare surgical brigade. **An excision of a 2 kg lipoma was performed.** Since surgery Mrs. Merlo's quality of life has dramatically improved.
